WANT TO GO TO COLLEGE? NOT SURE WHERE TO BEGIN?

The College Partnership Program (CPP) is a program designed to assist students who are traditionally underrepresented in higher education (first generation, African-American, Alaskan Native, Hispanic, limited English proficient, students with disabilities or economically disadvantaged students) explore, apply and enroll in college.

Examples of Services Provided:

- 5 amazing CPP advocates at Herndon!
- College processes information
- Field trips to college campuses
- Financial Aid and Scholarship support
- Test prep for SAT/ACT
- Presentations by guest speakers, including college admissions representatives

Application Process:

- First Time applicants must apply
 - February virtual information sessions
 - CPP advocates will send out information via email
- Returning CPP members do not need to reapply and are welcome back
