- ☐ May 1st is "National Decision" day. Once you decide upon the college you will attend, be sure to advise the other colleges that you will not attend.

| | Call the college financial aid office if your family's financial situation has changed – you CAN ask for more money! They may not be able to provide it to you, but you can ask. |
| MAY | |
| | Advise the college that you accept their acceptance by May 1st. Typically, there is a small deposit – be |
| | sure it's paid by their deadline. Advise the colleges that you will not be attending. This allows the college |
| | to open spots for the waitlist students. |
| | Make deposit to attending college – watch deadlines |
| | Register for your college's new student orientations (usually over the summer) |
| | Take Advanced Placement (AP) exams if applicable |
| | Apply for Civics Seal – through your Government class |
| | Complete the Senior Survey |
